Your intake materials can be electronically processed; an in-person intake appointment is not required. Please send an e-mail with this form and your Project Application to: CPC.Intake@sfgov.org. You will receive an e-mail confirmation within three business days that will include a comprehensive list of the documents required for your specific application type.

How to Submit Your Intake Materials Electronically via Our Public Portal:

<u>Project Applications</u> can be filed and paid for online 24 hours a day, 7 days a week via our <u>Public Portal</u>.

Only new projects that require an entitlement may be filed online. Projects that require a Building Permit must be submitted directly to the Department of Building Inspections located at: 49 South Van Ness Avenue, 2nd Floor, San Francisco, CA 94103.
